Introduction

Rhyming Multisensory Stories connect individuals with *special educational needs and disabilities* (aged 3-adult) to literature, topic, history and culture in a way that is fun, motivating and meaningful to their lives.

Stories are told through the senses using sensory stimuli, (*story props*), that provide new experiences to calm and alert the sensory system in a safe, therapeutic and motivating environment.

The *story props* are low budget items found around the home, garden and classroom.

Stories are fully resourced and their step-by-step format make them accessible Education Professionals, Parents, Siblings, Guardians, Childminders, Speech Therapists, Play Therapists, Support Workers, Activity Coordinators, Storytellers, Librarians and anyone with an interest in exploring storytelling through the senses in a fun and engaging way!

Each story includes themed, sensory extension activities that link to the EYFS Framework and areas of the KSI National Curriculum making them the perfect resource for Special Education (aged 3-19) EYFS, Mainstream Primary, Speech & Language and EAL students.

The Benefits of Multisensory Storytelling

1. Storytelling creates a bond between the storyteller and the story explorer enhancing and enriching experiences.

2. Rhyming Multisensory Stories connect the individual to literature, culture and topic in a fun and engaging way.

3. The stories form a base on which to scaffold learning enabling the student to work on personal goals and individual targets.

4. The activities in the stories are designed to promote:

Communication skills: Eye contact, listening, shared attention & language development

Self-confidence & well-being: Trying out new ideas & skills, practicing self-care & independence and enjoying achievement

Self-awareness: Asking for 'help', 'again' and 'more'

Opportunities to explore cause & effect and build anticipation skills

Physical development: Fine & gross motor skills

Knowledge about the environment & the world around us

Engagement in scientific experimentation and mathematical concepts

Development of social & emotional skills: Turn-taking & sharing and teamwork

5. The sensory stimuli (*story props*) are a tool for the story explorer to explore and express their likes, dislikes and sensory preferences and to have the opportunity to make choices. This information can be used to identify motivators or items to calm and individual when anxious, tired or stressed, identify triggers, (some you may wish to avoid, others to work on building tolerance through desensitisation in a safe and therapeutic environment) and used in the writing of care plans to enhance areas daily life.

What is a Multisensory Story?

A multisensory story is told using words and sensory stimuli (story props) to engage the senses.

Who are Multisensory Stories For?

Multisensory stories are aimed at individuals with special educational needs & disabilities from curious pre-schoolers to teenagers with complex needs and for Early Years, mainstream Primary, Speech & Language and EAL students.

The stories form an excellent base on which to scaffold learning, providing opportunities for the individual to work towards their personal learning goals and targets.

Each story includes themed, sensory extension activities that link to the EYFS Framework and areas of the KS1 National Curriculum.

Are the Stories for Sole Use in Educational Settings?

Absolutely not! The stories and poems are fully resourced, step by step guides, making them the perfect resource for Parents, Siblings, Guardians, Childminders, Speech Therapists, Play Therapists, Support Workers, Activity Coordinators, Storytellers, Librarians and anyone with an interest in exploring storytelling through the senses in a fun and engaging way!

Why Rhyming Multisensory Stories?

The combination of sensory stimuli, listening to the rhyme and rhythm and the repetitive structure of the stories, supports memory and aids learning, playing a crucial role in the development of early communication language skills; joint attention, eye-contact, turn-taking, anticipation and the learning of concepts.

What Are the Benefits of Multisensory Storytelling?

1. Storytelling creates a bond between the storyteller and the story explorer enhancing and enriching experiences.

2. Rhyming Multisensory Stories connect the individual to literature, culture and topic in a fun and engaging way.

3. The activities in the stories are designed to promote:

Communication skills: (eye contact, listening, shared attention & language development)

Self-confidence & well-being (trying out new ideas & skills, practicing self-care & independence and enjoying achievement)

Self-awareness: (asking for 'help', 'again' and 'more')

Opportunities to explore cause & effect and build anticipation skills

Physical development: (fine & gross motor skills)

Knowledge about the environment & the world around us

Engagement in scientific experimentation and mathematical concepts

Development of social & emotional skills: (turn-taking & sharing and teamwork).

4. The sensory stimuli (story props) are a tool for the story explorer to explore and express their likes, dislikes and sensory preferences and to have the opportunity to make choices. This information can be used to identify motivators or items to calm and individual when anxious, tired or stressed, identify triggers, (some you may wish to avoid, others to work on building tolerance through desensitisation in a safe and therapeutic environment) and used in the writing of care plans to enhance areas daily life.

Can Multisensory Stories Build Communication Skills?

Sensory stories are an excellent motivating tool for encouraging alternative communication systems, early communication skills, Makaton, sign language and to facilitate PECS exchanges. The stories build the confidence of learners with speech impediments and communication difficulties as they have a physical (story) prop to support the words they are saying.

How Do I Tell A Multisensory Story?

The multisensory stories are fully resourced and written as easy to follow, step-by-step guides. Slowly and clearly read each sentence introducing the story prop as the corresponding word appears.

How do I source my Story Props?

The stories and poems are fully resourced and with different options suggested for props.

The props are low budget items found around the home, classroom and garden.

FAQ

Remember!

You do not have to complete the whole story in one sitting. You can explore one or two sentences adding to the story in future sessions, it may take several sessions to complete the story.

Allow processing time.

Repetition is the key! Repeat the same story for a minimum of twice a week for a month then change to a different story.

Be allergy aware!

Like any other activity, ensure the activities are supervised by a responsible adult.

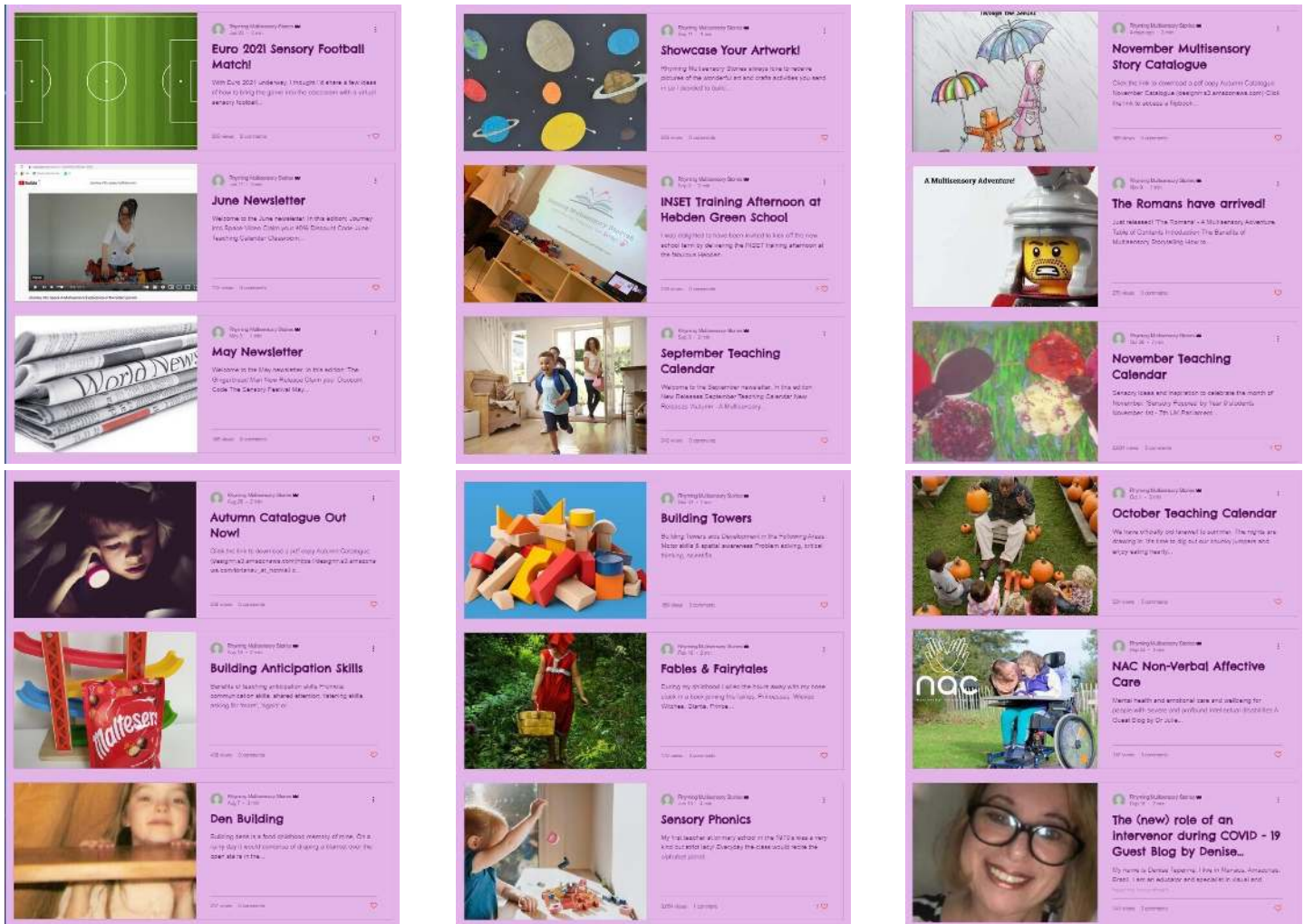
The interactions should be led by the story explorer who should be allowed to participate without expectation.

Never force stimuli and stop the activity if the story explorer shows signs that they are not enjoying the session.

Focus on having fun and it will become an educational experience!
